WHICH VACCINES ARE AVAILABLE IN CANADA?

There are currently 4 approved vaccines in Canada.



VACCINE NAME	# OF DOSES
Pfizer-BioNTech	2 doses
Moderna	2 doses
AstraZeneca	2 doses
Johnson & Johnson	1 dose

CAN I GET COVID FROM THE VACCINE?

NO

You cannot get COVID-19 from the vaccine. The vaccine does not contain the virus: it contains the instructions to recognize and protect you from the virus if you get exposed to it.



WHAT ARE SOME SIDE EFFECTS OF THE VACCINES?

Common side effects:

- Some pain at the injection site
- Body chills
- Feeling tired and/or feverish

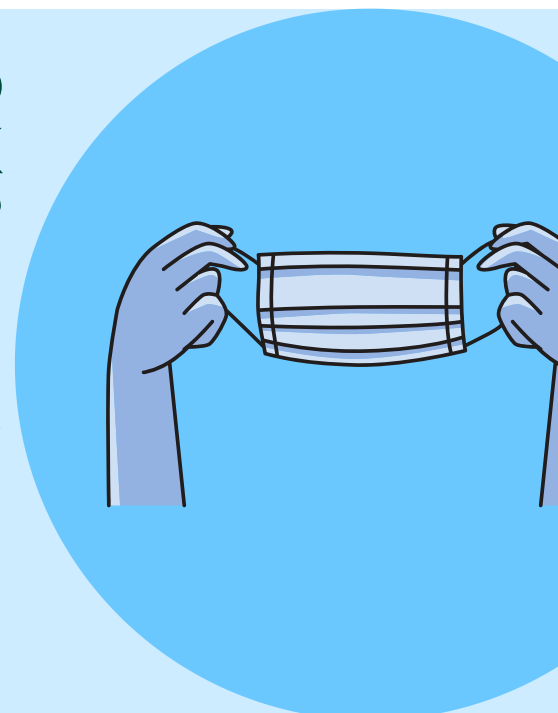
There are common side effects of vaccines and are not harmful to one's health.

The vaccine will prevent you from getting sick yourself. We are still learning about how the vaccines will stop the spread of COVID-19. It is important that everyone still continue to follow public health guidelines.
